- The score required is lower than an average score of 450.

The SAT scores are given as an average. The scores are rounded and cannot be considered guarantee of acceptance. They are intended to give a general idea of admission prospects:

- General average = total score/2.
- QE = Quantitative emphasis average: $0.67 \times \text{Math score} + 0.33 \times \text{ERW score}$
- VE = Verbal emphasis average: $0.67 \times \text{ERW score} + 0.33 \times \text{Math score}$
